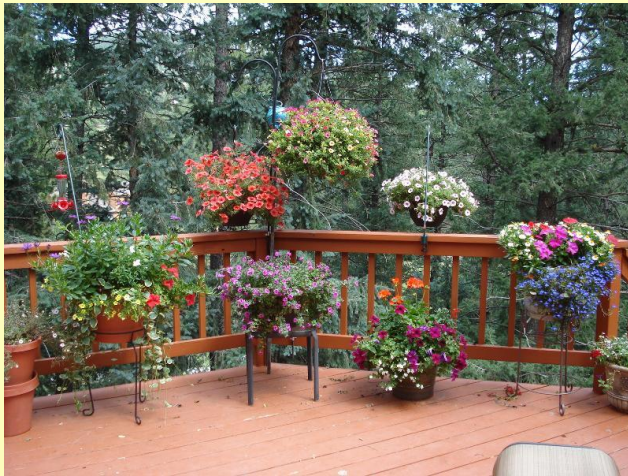




Sundance Stonework: Patios, Retaining Walls, Steps, & Walkways

Plant paperwhite bulbs now for indoor forcing. Flowers will bloom in November and December. Buy one bulb at regular price and get the second one at half price.



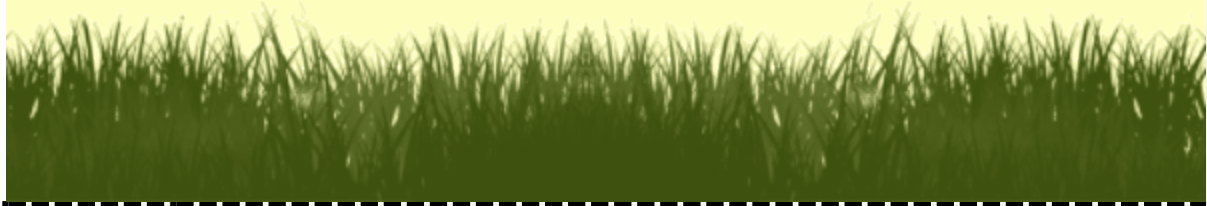
