Linda's Garden Tips



- Late fall is an excellent time to sow wildflower seed. Make sure the soil has been amended with compost and roughed up. Mix the seed in a bucket with some dry soil or sand to aid in even distribution. A ratio of 2 parts soil/sand to 1 part seed is best. It is helpful to broadcast the seed before an anticipated snowfall. Timing is critical for successful fall planting. It is important for the ground to be cold enough that germination does not occur until spring.

- Reminder: Place bone meal or superphosphate in the bottom of holes when planting bulbs...and keep well watered until ground

freezes.

- Keep the roots of plants strong for the upcoming winter by giving them a good soaking with kelp.

Fall Clean-up....rake, rake, rake

The extreme moisture this spring affected many aspen trees with foliage disease. If you noticed spots on your aspen leaves and experienced early leaf drop, be diligent about raking up and removing all affected leaves. Marssonina leaf spot is the most common aspen fungal disease. It survives the winter on fallen leaves and it's spores can re-infect emerging leaves next spring. For CSU disease management information [click here](#).
