

There are still plenty of chores to do in the garden. With the exceptionally wet spring and summer we've had so far, there are numerous types of blights, rots, rusts, fungi, molds, and other diseases that are attacking our plants. Egads! Sometimes it can be overwhelming. It's important to remove all the diseased foliage and dispose of it quickly, and not to let it overwinter in your garden.

It is also important to deadhead the annuals in your pots and hanging baskets. Be sure to

feed them with a 20-20-20 fertilizer.

Now is a good time to plant perennials, trees, and shrubs so they can take

root. August is usually our hottest month, so be sure to keep all your plants well watered. But most important is to sit and enjoy your garden in all it's glory!
