Linda's Garden Center Tip:

Who cares that in early February groundhog Punxsutawney Phil forecast 6 more weeks of winter?? Certainly not anyone who lives in the Rockies! We love those spring snows!!! We know how important that spring moisture is for keeping our forests healthy, keeping the wildfire danger low, for making stunning wildflower displays in the summer, and so much more.

For us Rocky Mountain gardeners, Spring is a state of mind. This is the time of year when we start planning for the growing season ahead, and at the top of the list is turning dirt into soil, or nurturing the soil we have.

Add amendments to your soil that include worm castings, organic compost, microbes, and mycorrhiza. Do this when the soil is not completely saturated with moisture.

It's also time to think about sowing some wildflower seed..ideally right before one of those spring snows!!
