May can be a very busy month for gardeners. Preparing the soil with organic material is always a chore, but is well worth the effort. Now is the time to plant cool weather crops such as potatoes, carrots, radishes, lettuce, spinach, broccoli, and cauliflower. It's also time to sow wildflower seed, and fertilize evergreen and flowering trees and shrubs. Sundance has slow-release fertilizer stakes. Just hammer them into the ground around the roots....easy and effective!



Mother's Day is May 10th. A flowering tree or shrub is a perfect gift that can last a lifetime. Lilacs are a favorite! And remember not to plant annuals till after Memorial Day.
